IANZ Unilateral Recognition of NATA Accreditation in the Discipline of Teleradiology

IANZ has observed a NATA assessment of an Australian teleradiology service and now considers the NATA process to be the equivalent of an IANZ radiology assessment. On this basis, IANZ unilaterally recognises NATA accreditation in the discipline of Teleradiology (as part of the RANZCR/NATA Accreditation Programme).

From August 2014, IANZ will accept reports from NATA accredited teleradiology facilities as equivalent to those from IANZ accredited services. IANZ accredited clients will now only need to provide evidence that the Australian teleradiology service:

- And the NZ client has appropriate communication and feedback mechanisms.
- Is NATA accredited for Teleradiology (currently only in Australia).
- For reporting NZ client examinations, only utilises radiologists who hold current annual practicing certification by the Medical Council of New Zealand.
